Ecological Civilization:Building a Shared Future for All Life on Earth  
KUNMING, CHINA

The first phase of the **Fifteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP 15)** was held in Kunming, China from 11 to 15 October and included a High-Level Segment, from 12 to 13 October. The second phase will be an in-person meeting, foreseen from 25 April to 8 May 2022 in Kunming. A series of roundtables were organised during this High-Level Segment (HLS), where two of our ministers made a statement, along with EU Commissioner for Environment. Please find below a summary of these statements.

**Minister Zakia Khattabi** (Minister of the Climate, the Environment, Sustainable Development and Green Deal):

- She presented on national conservation efforts at the federal and regional levels, including the establishment of a federal sustainable finance strategy.
- "Je peux vous annoncer l'élaboration d'une stratégie fédérale de financement durable qui reposera sur deux piliers: le rôle d'investisseur de l'état fédéral et la durabilité du secteur financier"

**Minister Céline Tellier** (Walloon Ministry of Environment, Nature, Animal Welfare and Rural Renovation):

- "Mon gouvernement, celui de la Belgique, s'inscrit pleinement dans l'objectif de préservation et de restauration des écosystèmes et soutient la restauration d'un réseau écologique permettant de préserver 30% des écosystèmes terrestres."



**Virginijus Sinkevičius**, EU Commissioner for Environment:

- "The EU and its Member States strongly support ambitious goals, milestones and targets, which should be measurable, where feasible. This includes a global target to protect and conserve at least 30% of the land and of the ocean globally by 2030."
- "We want to flag the urgent need for strong actions to protect marine and coastal biodiversity, including the open ocean and the deep-sea, taking account of the oceans and climate nexus."
- "This must go together with eliminating or redirecting incentives and subsidies harmful for biodiversity and scaling up positive ones as well as aligning all financial flows in support of biodiversity."
- "We stand ready to contribute to building a common understanding on the issue of digital sequence information and its linkages to ABS as a basis for identifying an innovative and constructive solution, which also guarantees that science, research and innovation can continue to bring full benefits that also support the implementation of the other objectives of the CBD."


