

SBI 4 convened from 21-29 May 2024 focused on the following agenda items:


- The financial mechanism;
- The draft capacity-building and development action plan for the Nagoya Protocol (NP);
- The Clearing-house Mechanism and knowledge
- management;Communication, education, and public awareness;
- Mechanisms for planning, monitoring, reporting, and review;
- capacity building and development, technical and scientific cooperation, and technology transfer;
- Resource mobilization;
- Review of implementation: progress in the preparation of revised or updated national biodiversity strategies and actions plans (NBSAPs) and the establishment of national targets:
- The long-term strategic approach to mainstreaming biodiversity;
- Review of effectiveness of processes under the Convention and its Protocols;
- Development of the methodology for the second assessment and review of the effectiveness of the NP;
- Cooperation with other conventions and international organizations;
- The multi-year programme of work (MYPOW) of the Conference of the Parties (COP); and
- Administrative and budgetary matters.

Meeting documents - outcomes

The political monitoring of the Belgian National Focal Point to the Convention on Biological Diversity carries out research on biodiversity and ecosystem-related topics at the level of the different Belgian legislative institutions: the Chamber, the Senate, the Walloon parliament, the parliament of the Walloon-Brussels federation, the Flemish parliament, the Brussels parliament and the European parliament. The monitoring aims to give a non-exhaustive overview of the different ongoing policy developments related to biodiversity and ecosystem services in these legislative institutions.
